General Description:

Bike Drop-Off (Thursday, October 24):

We will be packing the bikes prior to our Troop meeting on October 24. Bring your bike, helmet and a blanket to wrap your bike to the meeting between 6:45 and 7:15. Come early for the best parking spots!

Gear Needed:

See attached "Recommended Campout Equipment List". Travel uniforms will be required for Friday evening and Sunday morning transportation in the cars. Please dress appropriately for the weather.

Cost:

\$25 is the fee for this weekend for each participant (adult or scout). This fee covers all of your camping and riding fees, food, snacks, etc. Note: you will need to bring spending money for the ride up, treats along the trail and breakfast on the way home.
